Campers wanting a working spot must plan to attend all three days, no splitting/sharing of sessions will be allowed. Campers may work only one dog per session. If you want to work a second dog at the camp you must register for the lowest level of the dogs you plan to bring in order to not hold up an advanced group by working a less experienced dog on an exercise.

Disclaimer and Waiver of Liability

I hereby acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate in dog training activities with On Course Agility, LLC and Karen Holik (hereinafter collectively known as "On Course") and Surgi-Care Real Estate, II and K. Leanne Kuebelbeck (hereinafter collectively known as "Surgi-Care"). I am aware that there are inherent risks and hazards involved with and around dogs, and I am voluntarily participating in the activities with the knowledge of these potential dangers. I am not relying on On Course or Surgi-Care to prevent such occurrences. In order to participate in On Course training classes, demonstrations, or other activities, I, being fully informed of such risks and hazards, agree to assume ALL RISK OF SUCH OCCURRENCE. I hereby waive any and all claims or actions I or my guardians, representative or assigns may have against On Course or Surgi-Care and agree to release On Course and Surgi-Care from liability in any and all personal injuries to myself, my dog, children in my charge, or harm to property caused directly or indirectly by any acts that might occur in conjunction with dog training classes, or other activities. I also agree to assume sole responsibility for injury or damage caused by myself, children in my charge, or by the dog I own or handle during participation in On Course Agility classes, events and activities and further indemnify, defend, and hold On Course and Surgi-Care harmless from any damage, loss, liability, or expense, including legal costs and attorney fees, which result from damage caused by myself, children in my charge, or the dog I own or handle.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY -- I have carefully read this release of liability and fully understand the contents thereof. I am aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between On Course and Surgi-Care.

Cancellation Policy

As much as we care about all of our customers and their dogs, and we are extremely pained when we hear of either personal or canine tragedies, seminars are a business. We cannot keep running seminars if costs are greater than income and labor expended. We budget and hire instructors for seminars based on being able to fill an exact number of spots. The instructors and the facility don't care how many people ultimately attend camp – they charge us the same amount of money no matter what. We had to develop a cancellation policy that takes this into consideration and that treats everyone equally. We do not make exceptions to this policy as it is impossible to judge whether one person's emergency is more important and more deserving of a refund or credit than the next person's. We do the best we can to maintain an active waiting list, but we cannot guarantee that there will be a waiting list if you have to cancel. It is critical that you read the following information carefully as there are NO exceptions to our cancellation policy other than being called to active military duty.

Before October 15: All fees will be refunded with the exception of the \$200 non refundable deposit. **October 16 to January 1st:** 50% of the total fees paid will be refunded with the exception of the \$200 non refundable deposit. **January 1st to the start of camp:** 50% of the total fees paid will be refunded **ONLY IF YOUR SPOT CAN BE FILLED** with the exception of the \$200 non refundable deposit.

CANCELLATION POLICY -- I have read the above cancellation policy and I agree to all terms. I understand that there are NO EXCEPTIONS to the policy regardless of the reason that I cancel my Camp reservation.
